is One hundred and five pounds ~~per~~ by the year for a
term of Twenty one year without Variation the whole
of which is due and payable to the Rev. George Sturson
a Rector and Vicar of said Parish. and we do further
Certify that the average price of Wheat being the Com-
modity principally grown in such County for the period of seven
years ending on the 1st Day of Novem^r. 1821, is One pound
eighteen Shillings and eight pence half penny per bush.
