of composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or
payable within the parish of Tullamaine in the County
of Kilkenny. ~~Do hereby certify that the true and just amount~~
is one hundred and five pounds Sterling by the year
for a Term of Twenty one year without cessation, the
whole of which is due and payable to the Rev^d George
Stevenson as Rector and Vicar of said parish. And
We do further certify that the average price of Wheat
being the Corn principally grown in such County for
the period of seven year ending on the 1st day of Novem-
ber 1821 is one pound eighteen shillings and eight pence
halfpenny per Quarter tate Irish currency. Dated this
