I, Andrew Bish Commission duly  
appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an Act  
made in the Second and Third years of the Reign  
of His Majesty William the Fourth, entitled "An Act to  
amend three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth,  
Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth years of the  
Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth,  
providing for the establishment of Compositors for tithes  
in Ireland; and to make such Compositors paramount,  
to ascertain and fix a true and just Compositors for  
all tithes arising, present, yielded, or payable  
within the Parish of Gullahought, in the County  
of Kerry do hereby certify that the true and  
just amount of Compositors for all tithes whatever  
within the said Parish is One Hundred and Eighty  
one pounds by the year, which sum is due and payable  
to the Most Noble James Mervin of Armarole  
as a Compositor for the tithes claimable by him as  
Lay Proprietor of the said Parish.

And I do further certify, that the  
average price of wheat being the grain principally  
grown in such County, for the period of Seven years  
ending on the first day of November One thousand  
eight hundred and thirty is One pound Twelve  
shillings and one halfpenny per Bushel.
