

In the Matter of an application to vary
the Tithe Rent Charge of the Parish of Tullahaught in
the Diocese of Ossory and County of Wick and
the Act of 142 Victoria Chapter 109.

WHEREAS, it appearing to the County Court Judge
and Chairman and Justices presiding at the Quarter
Sessions of the Peace for the Division of Thomastown
and County of Wick held at Thomastown for the
said Division and County on the fourteenth day of October
One thousand eight hundred and ninety that Thomas William
Anderson, George Wm Morris and William Power being
three Landholders in the Parish of Tullahaught in the
Diocese of Ossory in the County of Wick each of
whom is respectively liable to and charged with the Annual
payment of the sum of three pounds and upwards for
Rent Charge in lieu of Composition for tithes within the
said Parish (other than Tithe Rent Charge which became
vested in the Commissioners of Church Temporalities
in Ireland under or by virtue of the Irish Church Act
1869 or the Acts amending the same) caused a notice in
writing signed by them to be posted on the principal
outer doors of every known place of worship in said
Parish on two successive Sundays since the first day of May
one thousand eight hundred and ninety the last of such
Sundays being more than eight days previous to the day of
holding the ensuing Quarter Sessions of the County in which
the said Parish is situate signifying that it was their intention
to make an application to the Justices of the Peace at said
Quarter Sessions to be held at Thomastown on the said fourteenth
day of October One thousand eight hundred & ninety to have
the average price of wheat for the seven years preceding in
