

Certificate for the Compensation of Tithe in the Parish
of Tullinstown — We James Pringle & John Davis
Commissioners duly appointed & sworn under
virtue of an Act made in the Reign of King George
the 4th the 1st of the said Act to provide for the compensation
for Tithe in Ireland for a limited time to wit
I give a true & just computation for all Tithe arising
growing, yielding or payable to the Rev. W. H. Armstrong
within the Parish of Tullinstown in the Co. of Wicklow
& Diocese of Ossory as having at that time
a just amount of compensation for all his Tithe
whatsoever within said Parish for hundred &
two pounds twelve shillings by the year, being the
sum agreed upon it and by a special Vestry held
on the 30th day of June last past between the Rev.
W. H. Armstrong, Rector of said Parish & said special
Vestry under & by virtue of the provisions of the
27th section of the said Act, as a compensation
for all Tithe being the moiety of the Tithe great
and small payable by him as Rector of said
Parish & said compensation to continue unrevoked
for the term of twenty one years
