

Certificate for the Composition of Tithes in the Parish
of Sullinstown — We James Pringle & John Davers
Composers duly appointed & sworn under and by
virtue of an Act made in the Reign of King George
the 4th the 1st of the 1st Session ^{an Act} for providing for the composition
of Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to wit
I give & bear & pay composition for all Tithes arising
growing, yielding or payable to the Rev^d W^m Armstrong
within the Parish of Sullinstown in the Co. of Wick
& Diocese of Ossory, do hereby certify that the true
& just amount of composition for all his Tithes
whatsoever within said Parish is two hundred &
two pounds six shillings & six pence by the year, which
sum is agreed upon & by a special Vestry held
on the 30th day of June last past between the Rev^d
W^m Armstrong Rector of said Parish & said Special
Vestry under & by virtue of the provisions of the
27th Section of the said recited Act, as a Composition
for all Tithes being the moiety of the Tithes great
and small claimable by him as Rector of said
Parish & said Composition to continue unrevoked
for the term of twenty one years
