

I William Middleton Commissioner duly appointed and
sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the 2nd and
3rd year of the reign of King William the fourth entitled an
Act to amend three Acts pass'd respectively in the fourth
fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his
late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the establishing
a composition for Tithes in Ireland and to make such composition
permanent to ascertain & fix a true and just composition for all
Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish
of Tullowherin in the County of Kilkenny — Do hereby Certify
that the true and just amount of composition for all Tithes what-
ever within the said Parish is Two Hundred and Fifty Pounds
per year which sum is due and payable to the Rev^d. Grimes
Irwin as Composition for the Vicarial Tithes of all said Parish
claimable by him as Vicar thereof. And I do further Certify
that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally growing
in such County for the period of Seven years ending the first
day of November 1830 — is Thirty-two Shillings and One
Halfpenny per Barrel given under my hand this 18th day of
October 1833
