duly appointed and sworn as Commissioner under
and by virtue of an act made in the Fourth year
of the reign of King George the Fourth entitled, "An
Act to provide for the establishing of Composition for
Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" And by vir-
tue of an act passed in the second and third years
of reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth
entitled "An Act to amend three acts passed
respectively, in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the
seventh and eighth years of the reign of his
late Majesty King George the Fourth, provided
for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes
in Ireland, and to make such compositions
permanent, and to ascertain and fix, a true
and just composition for all Tithes, arising
growing yielded or payable within the Parish
of Tully, in the County of Kildare, do hereby
certify that the true and just amount of
Composition for all Tithes whatever within the
said Parish is three hundred and twenty three
pounds, seventeen shillings and three pence half
penny by the year, of which sum, £ 323..17..3½
are due and payable to the Bishop of Kildare
as a composition for the Tithes claimable by
