 limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition
 for All Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the
 Parish of Buvris in the Diocese of Cashel and County of
 Tipperary, Do hereby Certify, that the true and just Amount
 of Composition for All Tithes whatever within the said Parish
 of Buvris, is Six Hundred Pounds by the Year: which Sum
 of Six Hundred Pounds is due and payable to the Reverend
 Richard French Lawrence as a Composition for the Tithes
 claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of the said Parish.

And We do further Certify, that the Average
 price of Wheat, being the Corn principally grown in such
 County, for the period of Seven Years ending on the First day
 November One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty One,
 according to a Schedule thereof furnished by the Right Honorable
 Henry Goulburn Chief Secretary to the Lord Lieutenant of
 Ireland, is One Pound Eighteen Shillings and Eight pence
 halfpenny late Currency, or One Pound Fifteen Shillings and
 Eight pence Three farthings. British per Barrel.
