 limited time to ascertain & fix a true & just  
 Composition for all Tithes whatever arising  
 growing yielding or payable within the  
 Parish of Inyagh in the County of Galway  
 do hereby certify that the true and just  
 amount of Composition for all Tithes  
 whatever in said Parish is two hundred  
 & thirty eight Pounds six Shillings & eight pence  
 payable by the year whereof two hundred  
 & fifteen Pounds five shillings & four pence  
 is due & payable to the Reverend  
 James Henry Buttou Rector of said Parish  
 thirty six Pounds one Shilling & four pence  
 is due and payable to the Lord Bishop  
 of Clonfert as his Lordships proportion  
 two Pounds are due and payable  
 to the Vicar Choral of Christ Church  
 Dublin and fifteen Pounds are due  
 and payable by the year to the Honble  
 & Res<sup>d</sup> Maria Mahon as preliminary  
 and we do hereby certify that  
 the average price of oats being the Com  
 principally grown in said County  
 for the period of seven years ending  
 the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1821, namely one  
 is thirteen Shillings and six pence per  
 Acre.
