

Such Quarter Sessions and the said Notice Certificate and
the average price of wheat as advertised in the Dublin Gazette
for the said period of 7 years having been proved. Now
the said Justices do ascertain from the said Gazette that
the average price of wheat for the said period of 7 years is
for each ^{and} barrel of twenty stone ^{and two pence for barrel of twenty stone} and the said Justices do
accordingly order and adjudge that the amount of the said
composition in the said Parish and the rent charges
payable in lieu thereof shall be diminished in proportion
to the difference between the said average price for the said
period of 7 years and the average price as stated in
said Certificate of composition and that the applotment
of such composition be amended accordingly And the
said Justices do further order that the reduction do take
effect from the 1st day of November 1854. Dated this 23rd
