Whereas by Our Order of the 20<sup>th</sup> day of August 1834,  
it was ordered and directed that the Appletment of  
the Tithes Composition for the Parish of Wallstown  
in the Diocese of Cloyne and County of Cork, be  
amended pursuant to the provisions of the Act of the  
1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> years of the Reign of Her present Majesty  
entitled "An Act to abolish Compositions for Tithes  
in Ireland, and to substitute Rent Charges in lieu thereof"  
and Messrs. Tereuca Brossman, of Charleville, and  
John Cupen, of Teale, Mallow, both in said County,  
were by said Order appointed to carry into effect,
