


We Benjamin Deble and Howard Wiseman, Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of ^{the reign of} King George the Fourth entitled an Act to provide for the Establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, and also of an Act made in the Fifth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth entitled an Act to amend an Act of the last Session of Parliament for providing for the Establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland to ascertain and fix a true and just Compositions for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding, or payable within the Parish of Temple Gall otherwise White Church, partly in the County of Cork and partly in the County of the City of Cork. Do hereby Certify that the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Eight Hundred and Fifty pounds sterling by the year payable to the Rev James Kingston, Clerk, Doctor of Laws, as Rector and Vicar of said Parish, pursuant to an agreement entered into by the said James Kingston, and a Special Vestry of said Parish,

And We do farther Certify that the average Price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in said Counties for the Period of seven years ending the first day of November One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy One is Fifteen Shillings & Two Pence Farthing per Barrell.
