


We Benjamin Deeble and Howard Wiseman Commissioners

establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a  
limited time and also of an act made in the fifth year  
of the Reign of King George the fourth Entitled an act  
to amend an act of the last Session of Parliament for pro-  
viding for the establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ire-  
land to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition  
for all Tithes arising growing yielding or Payable  
within the Parish of Templeall otherwise White Church  
partly in the County of Cork and partly in the Coun-  
ty of the City of Cork. Do hereby Certify that the  
true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes  
whenever within the said Parish is Eight Hun-  
drd and Fifty Pounds Sterling by the Year Pay-  
able to the Reverend James Hingston Clerk, Doctor  
of Law, as Rector and Vicar of said Parish pur-  
suant to an agreement Entered into by the said  
James Hingston and a Special meeting of said  
Parish.

and we do further Certify that the  
average price of oats being the Corn principally  
grown in said Counties for the Period of Seven  
years Ending the first day of November one  
Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty one is  
Fifteen Shillings and Two pence Farthing per Pannell  
Dated this second day of August one Thousand Eight
