I George Rait having been duly appointed and sworn as Commissioner under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth entitled an act to provide for establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, and by virtue of an act passed in the second & third years of the Reign of His Majesty King William the fourth entitled an act to amend three acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth and in the seventh and eight years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such compositions permanent, and to ascertain and fix a true & just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the parish of White Church in the County of Kildare, do hereby Certify that the true & just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is One Hundred and five pounds by the year, of which sum of £105- the sum of sixty pounds is due
