

Sir You are hereby required to take Notice that in
pursuance of an Act passed in the 2nd and 3rd year of
his present Majesty entitled an Act to amend 3 Acts passed
respectively the 1st 5th and in the 7th and 8th years of
the reign of his late Majesty King George the 4th providing
for establishing Composition for Tithes in Ireland and
to make such Composition permanent I John
Kennedy of Dunbrody in the County of Wexford
being seized by Virtue of Lease under Arthur Annesley
Esq for the unexpired term of two Lives and 31 years
Consent of all that and those that part of the
Lands of Horeswood now in the possession of my
under tenants situate in the Parish of Kilmotea
Barony of Shelburne and County of Wexford or
otherwise entitled according to the Provisions of said
Act to agree for and undertake the payment of the
Composition for Tithes lawfully payable for and in
respect of such Lands do hereby signify to you my
Desire to agree for and undertake the payment of such
Composition as aforesaid for and in respect of the
said Lands and I hereby require you to grant me
a Certificate in Writing conformable to the provisions
of said Act declaring me entitled to the Benefit
of this Act and to perform the other matters on
your part required by the said Act to be done.
