At the Notice that I Alexander Carroll of Mount Argus  
in the County of Dublin Esq<sup>r</sup> being seized in fee of and in  
the Lands and premises hereafter mentioned Do hereby agree  
and undertake for the future payment of the Title Composition  
chargeable on All that and those the Town and Lands of  
Ballymagraw situate in the Parish of Wicklow, bounded  
on the East by the Lands of Ballynclough, on the West  
by the Lands of Kilcaudracumhans on the North by  
the Lands of Ballymanus and an Old Road and on  
the South by the Lands of Baalbeg containing by estimation  
142 Acres at thereabouts being now in possession of my several  
undertakings pursuant to the provisions of the 3<sup>rd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> of  
Wm<sup>4</sup> Cap 119 deducting therefrom 15 per cent per  
annum. I have therefore to request that you will furnish  
me with an account of the sum payable out of said  
Lands and also will a certificate required by the 22<sup>nd</sup>  
Section of the above named Act of Parliament.
