

I, Arthur Belcher of Glenjige Lodge, Commissioned - duly appointed & sworn, under and by virtue of an Act, made the 2^d & 3^d years of the Reign of King William the V. intituled an Act, to amend three Acts, pass^d respectively in the 14th 5th & in the 7th & 8th years of the Reign of his late Majesty King Geo. the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent, to ascertain & fix a true & just Composition for all the Tithes arising, growing or payable within the Parish of Woollegrange in the County of Wick, do hereby Certify that the true & just amount of Composition for all the Tithes whatev^r within the said Parish is, One Hundred & Eighty eight Pounds Sterl. - which is due and payable to the Rev^d Richard Butler as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector & Vicar of said Parish. And I do further certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said County, for the Period of Seven years ending on the 31st day of October 1830 (Thirty) is One Pound Twelve Shillings & one half penny per Bannet -
