

We William Smithwick & George Watson Com-
missioners duly appointed and sworn under
and by Virtue of an act made in the fourth
year of the reign of King George the 4th entitled
an act for establishing a composition for
Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to as-
ertain & fix a true and just composition
for all tithes arising growing yielded or
payable within the Parish of Donohoe area
in the county of Tipperary. Do certify that
the true and just amount of composition for
all tithes whatever within the said Parish is
Four Hundred & Fifty one pounds by the year
of which sum of Four Hundred and Fifty one
pounds the whole are due and payable to the
Rev Robert Gabbett LL.D as a composition
for the tithes claimable by him as Rector
and Vicar of said Parish.

And we do further certify that the average
price of wheat being the corn principally
grown in such county for the period of seven
years ending the first day of November eighteen
hundred and twenty one is One pound eighteen
Shillings & eight pence halfpenny per Bunch -
dated this 10th day of April 1824.
