Parish is Two hundred and fifty Pounds by the Year
all which sum is due and payable to the Rev^d Tho^s.
Brooke as a Composition for the Tythe claimable by
him as Rector of the Said Parish as agreed upon
between the said Rev^d Tho^s. Brooke and the Parishioners
of said Parish -
