said Parish is Two hundred and fifty Pounds
by the year all which sum is due and payable
to the Rev. Tho. Brooke as a Composition for the
Tythe claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish
as agreed upon between the said Rev. Tho. Brooke
and the Parishes of said Parish -
