Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth intituled "An act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited Time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the parish of Kiltenny in the County of Kerry. do hereby certify that the Just and true Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said parish is one hundred and thirty pounds by the year of which sum of one hundred and thirty pounds, one half is due and payable to the Earl of Forke as owner of the Rectorial Tithes and one half is due & payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Edwin Thomas the Vicar of said parish

And we further certify that the Average price of oats, being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of Seven years ending on the first day of November 1821 is fifteen shillings per Bannet
