to enter into a composition for the tithes of this parish
according to the provisions of the aforesaid Act - being
the fourth, George, fourth, Chap 99 -

Resolved that the Reverend Archdeacon Watson
be appointed Commissioner on the part of the
Incumbent - and Peter Geoghagan Esq. on the
part of the Parish

The Incumbent (The Reverend Edward
Hartigan) having proposed to take thirty five
pounds the year for his proportion of tithes, and
the Rev. Archdeacon Watson - on the part of
the Lord Bishop of Clermont having proposed
to take fifty five pounds by the year for twenty
one years from November next - as his Lordship's
proportion of tithes

do allow the same and it is hereby accordingly
allowed

been produced

proceed to investigate the Dean's Claim to his
