Parish — In presence of the Churchwarden, and  
vestrymen, entitled to vote, being present —

" that the true and just amount of the composition  
" for all Tithes whatsoever within the Parish of Abbygormogers

" Sixty by the year — One Hundred and Seventeen Pounds  
" Sixty is due and payable to the Chd: Court of the Bishop  
" as Rector & Vicar of said Parish; Fifty five pounds  
" Sixty is due and payable to the Chd: Vicar of the same
