

At a Vestry held in the Parish Church of Miltmore on  
 Easter Tuesday the 20<sup>th</sup> of April 1824 for the Parishes of Miltmore  
 Killoran and Abbeymorgan of which due notice was given  
 the Lords Day next before <sup>the</sup> Church Wardens, and Parishoners  
 being assembled Resolved that the sum of fifty  
 one Pound, eight Shillings be appropriated and Levied off  
 the lands composing the Union for the purposes following

For signing the Bills of the said Union  
 Resolved that moderate part of  
 Parliament, that only 5-12-0 was demanded of the 12 taxa on or before  
 accounts of Loans to First Entry and that the balance be <sup>paid</sup> on the 1<sup>st</sup> of July  
 and the remaining sum to supply the contingencies  
 of the current year to be accounted for by the Churchwardens  
 - do - Resolved that Mr. Shaffer Esq. be  
 continued Churchwarden - and also that Mr. Villington  
 Resolved that it appears there is a large portion of land
