

A Vestry held on the 29th day of March 1826, at the Parish Church of the town of Biltmore, in the parishes of Biltmore, Kiloran and Liberty town, of which due notice was given; The Vicar and Parishioners being present; Resolved, that the sum Eighty Pounds be levied off the lands composing the Union for the following purposes, viz:

Season's Salary	5-13-9

 which will become due 1st July 1826

And, the remaining sum to be applied to the purchase of a Belfry for the Church, Church Books and silver Paten for the Communion Service.

Resolved, that Thomas Stratford Esq and Thomas Seymour Esq be appointed Church Wardens for the ensuing year.

Resolved, that this Vestry be adjourned to Monday the 24th day of April 1826 — for settling the accounts of the late Church Wardens: — and confirming the Appointments.
