

1024 Whereas by an act of vestry held on the 24th day
of April one thousand eight hundred and twenty six
at the Parish Church of Pitborough of which due
notice was given, it was resolved that the sum of Eighty
Pounds be raised and levied of the lands comprising
the Vicarage for the purposes in the said act of vestry
and a vestry having been held this day to examine
into the same, the Vicar Church Warden and
Parishioners present having examined and the same
affidavit do certify and confirm the same

Resolved that the sum of nineteen pounds
eight shillings and a halfpenny remaining in the Church
Wardens hands for the years 1823, and 1824 together
with the sum of fifty two pounds, as stated in the
Rep^t of 1825, have been satisfactorily accounted for
and it appears that a balance of eleven pounds
four shillings and four pence three farthings has
been paid over and above by the Church Warden
and that the amt of same is due to them -
and that they be empowered to clear the amt
due from the sum proposed for the present year
