At a Vestry held on Monday the 17th day of ~~May~~ April 1827 at the Parish Church of the Union of Kiltormer for the Parishes of Kiltormer Kiltoran and Abbeygormagan of which due notice was given the Church Warden and parishioners being present, it was resolved that the sum of Seventy five pounds nineteen shillings and eight pence be assessed and levied off the lands comprising the union for the purposes in the said act of Vestry - and a Vestry having been held this day to examine into the same &c the Church Warden and Parishioners present having examined into the same applotment do ratify and confirm the same -

Resolved That at the vestry held on the 17th day of April last the salary for the Sexton viz: £ 5-5-0. was omitted by mistake to be inserted at the said sum of £ 5-5. was voted at the time - It is now resolved that the said sum of £ 5-5. be added to the applotment. -

Resolved that the sum of Three pounds four shillings be now applotted, in addition to the former applotment for providing Coffins agreeably to the late Vestry act. -

Resolved that the sum of nineteen shillings and seven pence farthing being an arrear from the year 1825. together with the sum of Eighty six pounds thirteen shillings and four pence ~~the~~ late Irish Bearer as voted for the Act of 1826. have been satisfactorily accounted for and it appears that a balance of Five pounds sixteen shillings and two pence three farthings has been paid over and above by the Church Warden and that the amount of same is due to them - Resolved that the said sum of £ 5-16-2³/₄. be now applotted in addition to the former applotment, and be paid to the Church Warden aforesaid.
