 by a reference to the act of Vestry of the 17th of April last it
 appeared, that a sum of £5:16:2¹/₄ was lawfully due to the
 Churchwardens to reimburse them for so much Expended by
 them for the use of the Parish, and about the same sum collected by
 them from off the Parish.
