ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all  
'TITHES arising, growing, yielded or payable, within the

in the County of *Wexford* do hereby certify that  
the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes  
whatever within the said Parish, is *£126.0.0* Pounds  
~~Shillings and~~ Pence by the Year,  
of which Sum of *£126.0.0* Pounds ~~Shillings~~  
and ~~Pence~~ are due and payable to the  
following Persons, as a Composition for the Tithe  
claimable by them, viz: - *him viz. To the Rev<sup>d</sup>*

*Thomas Ottuill Moore of Leskinfere*  
*Glebe - Rector of the Parish of Kiltusk*

And I do further certify that the Average Price of *Wheat*  
being the Corn principally grown in such  
County, for the Period of Seven Years, ending on the *first*  
Day of *November 1830* is *£1.12.0*  
~~Shillings~~ per Barrel.
