

The the undersigned being appointed commissioners
 by Vestry, and by the Lords Justices in Council
 to apportion the sum of three hundred and twelve
 pounds six shillings and nine pence, in the
 Parish of Heltraston being the amount as
 certified to us of all tithes payable out of
 said Parish. We find the Parish to contain
 three thousand two hundred and six by
 acres one rood & twenty perches of the best
 or plantation measure. Valuable property, which
 we have clasped into three different qualities
 viz 1135 3/4 22 first quality of 8 1/2 by second
 quality & 1147 1/2 of spotted quality. That
 the sum of £404 2/3 being the one third of
 said tithes are due and payable to the Vicar
 of the sum of £208 4/3 being the remaining
 two third parts are due and payable to the
 Vicar of said parish: which sums we have
 apportioned on each occupier of land in said
 parish: and have afterwards deducted 25
 per cent off each. We have also charged
 each Landlord with the gross amount and
 have after deducting 25 per cent shown the
 net amount payable by each, to the respective
 proprietors. Given under our hands
