Sworn a Commissioner under and by Virtue of an Act
made in the second and third years of the Reign of
King William the 4th. Intituled an Act to amend
three Acts passed in the 1st, 5th and in the 7th & 8th
years of his late Majesty King Geo. the 4th. providing
for the establishing of Compositions in Ireland
and to make such Compositions permanent, to
ascertain and fix a true and just compensation
for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding or payable
within the Parish of Kellubride in the County of
Leitrim, do hereby Certify that the true and just
composition for all Tithes whatever within the
Said Parish is Two hundred and Eighty one
pounds Starting by the year of which Sum of
Two hundred and Eighty one pounds is due and
payable to George, D. Mansfield as a Compens-
-ation claimable by him as Rector of Said Parish
of Kellubride. And I do further Certify that the
Average price of Oats being the Corn principally
grown in such County for the period of seven years
ending the first day of November Five thousand Eight
hundred and thirty is twelve Shillings per Barrel
dated this 26th day of November 1833
