

I William H. Lawder having been duly appointed and  
sworn a Commissioner under and by virtue of an Act  
made in the Second and third years of the Reign of  
King William the 4th Intituled an Act to amend  
Three Acts passed in the 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and in the 7 & 8<sup>th</sup>  
years of his late Majesty King Geo. the 4<sup>th</sup>. providing  
for the establishing of Compositions in Ireland  
and to make such Compositions permanent, to  
ascertain and fix a true and just compensation  
for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding or payable  
within the Parish of Killabridge in the County of  
Leitrim, do hereby certify that the true and just  
composition for all Tithes whatever within the  
said Parish is Two hundred and Eighty one  
pounds Sterling by the year, of which sum of  
Two hundred and Eighty one pounds is due and  
payable to George, D. Mansfield as a compen-  
sation claimable by him as Rector of said Parish  
of Killabridge. And I do further certify that the  
average price of Oats being the Corn principally  
grown in such County for the period of Seven years  
ending the first day of November One thousand eight  
hundred and thirty is twelve Shillings  $\frac{4}{4}$  per barrel  
dated this 26<sup>th</sup> day of November 1833 —
