Lawder having been duly appointed and sworn a Commissioner under and by Virtue of an Act made in the second and third years of the Reign of King William the 4<sup>th</sup> Intituled an Act to amend three Acts passed in the 1<sup>st</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and in the 10<sup>th</sup> years of his late Majesty King Geo the fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent. to Ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising growing yield-  
ing or payable within the Parish of Killubride in the County of Leitrim. do hereby certify that the true and just Composition for all tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two hundred and Eighty one pounds Sterling by the year of which sum of Two Hundred and Eighty one pounds is due and payable to George D. Mansfield as a composition claimable by him as Rector of said Parish of Killubride. And I do further certify that the Average price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending the first day of November <sup>One thousand Eight</sup> hundred and thirty is twelve Shillings <sup>and eleven pence</sup> per Barrel dated this 26<sup>th</sup> day of November 1833 -
