

We Pierce Blake of Dollypark and John Allman of Brecourt Esq^r Com-
-missioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the
4th year of the reign of King George the fourth entitled an act for the establishing of composition
for tithes in Ireland for a limited time. To us certain and for a true and just composi-
-tion for all tithes arising growing payable or payable within the parish of Kiltolla in
the county of Galway do hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition
for all tithes whatever within the said parish is two hundred and twenty one pound
twelve shillings sterling by the year, of which sum of two hundred and twenty one pound
twelve shillings, one hundred and fifty six pounds twelve shillings are due and pay-
-able to Alexander Macaulay and his successors as a composition for the tithes payable
-able by him as Rector of said Parish, twenty four pounds is due and payable to
the Bishop of Clonfert and his successors five pounds is due and payable to Thomas
Hawkins as Dean of Clonfert and his successors, thirty five pounds sterling are
due and payable to James Strange Watson as Archdeacon of Clonfert and his
-successors. We do further certify that the average price of oats being the corn
principally grown in such county for the period of seven years ending the first
day of November 1821 is ten shillings and sixpence by the Barrell - Signed Sealed
