the establishing of Composition for tythes in Ireland
and to make such composition permanent" to ascertain
& fix a true and just composition for all tythes
arising growing yielded or payable within the
parish of Kiltullagh & County of Roscommon do hereby
certify that the true and just amount of Composition
for all tythes whatever within the said parish is two
hundred and twenty seven pounds six shillings and eleven
pence halfpenny by the year of which sum of two hundred
and twenty seven pounds six shillings and eleven pence
halfpenny the whole is due and payable to the rector
of the said parish

And I do further certify that the average price
of Oats being the grain principally grown in said County
for the period of seven years ending on the first day
of November 1830 (thirty) is twelve shillings and eleven pence
half penny per barrel
