To hereby certify that the true and just amount
of compositions for all Tithes whatsoever within the
Parish is Eighty three pounds by the year of which
sum of Eighty three pounds the sum of thirty
eight pounds are due and payable to the
Rev^d Dean of Achonry as a composition
for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector
of the said Parish the said sum of thirty eight
pounds being the moiety of the Tithes arising
and payable by and out of the four
