

We John Curran and Charles O'Mara Esqrs commissioners  
duly appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of  
an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King  
George the fourth (entitled an Act to provide for establishing  
a composition for Tithes for a limited period) and  
amended by an Act made in the fifth year of the  
Reign of the said King Chap 53 to ascertain and fix  
a true composition for all Tithes arising growing  
yielded or payable within the Parish of Kilarnett  
in the County of Tipperary -

To hereby Certify that the true and just amount  
of composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the  
Parish is Eighty three pounds by the year of which  
Sum of Eighty three pounds the sum of thirty  
eight pounds one shilling and payable to the  
very Rev<sup>d</sup> the Dean of Achonry as a composition  
for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the  
said Parish the said Sum of thirty eight pounds  
being the moiety of the Tithes accruing and payable  
by several out of the following four Townlands  
respectively in said Parish viz Clarah (excepting  
the subdenomination of Cansontecane) Timbrough  
Kathyan and Bathananus and the sum
