just composition for all Tithes arising growing yearly
or payable within the Parish of Kilmarnock in the County of
Sligo do hereby certify that the true and just amount of
composition for all Tithes whatsoever within said Parish is
Eighty eight pounds by the year of which sum of eighty
eight pounds Forty pounds ten shillings are due and
payable to the very Rev^d the Dean of Keshom as compensa-
-tion for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of said
Parish And the sum of forty seven pounds ten shillings
is due and payable to the Rev^d Archdeacon Joseph Verschoyle
the Vicar of the said Parish

And we do further certify that the average Price of
Oats being the Corn principally grown in such County
for the Period of seven years ending the 1st Day of November
one thousand eight Hundred & twenty one is fifteen
Shillings & two pence 1/2 Bar^l
