year of the Reign of King George the fourth - entitled an Act  
to provide for the establishing of composition for Tithes in  
Ireland for a limited Time - to ascertain and fix a true and  
just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or  
payable within the Parish of Bilsnart in the County of  
Sligo. We hereby certify that the true and just amount of  
composition for all Tithes whatever within said Parish is  
Eighty eight pounds by the year; of which sum of eighty  
eight pounds Forty pounds ten Shillings are due and  
payable to the very Rev the Dean of Achary, as compo-  
sition for the Tithe claimable by him as rector of the said  
Parish; And that the sum of forty seven pounds & ten  
Shillings is due and payable to the Rev Archdeacon  
Joseph Vasebyle the Vicar of said Parish

And we do further <sup>certify</sup> that the average Price of Oats,  
being the Corn principally grown in such County, for the  
Period of seven years ending the 1<sup>st</sup> Day of November  
one thousand eight Hundred and twenty one, is fifteen
