duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made  
in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth,  
entitled "An Act to Provide for the Establishment of Composit<sup>ion</sup>  
for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain  
and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising  
growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Kilvine  
in the County of Mayo do hereby Certify that the true  
and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever  
within the said Parish is One Hundred and twenty six  
Pounds ten Shillings Sterling by the Year, which sum  
is payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Thomas Coffey as a Composition  
for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of said Parish  
Signed Sept<sup>r</sup> 25<sup>th</sup> 1824.
