Extract from the Registry of the Diocese of Tuam  
The 19<sup>th</sup> May 1855.

We James Cuff Blake & Neterville Blake Commissioners  
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act  
made in the Fourth year of the Reign of King George the  
Fourth Intituled "an Act to provide for the Establishment of  
Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time"  
to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes  
arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of  
Kibriche in the County of Mayo Do hereby certify that  
the true and just Composition for all Tithes whatever within  
the said Parish is One Hundred and Twenty Six pounds  
Ten Shillings Sterling by the year which Sum is due  
and payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Thos Coffey as a Composition  
for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the  
said Parish.
