I further Certify, that the average price of Oats, being the Corn principally grown in said Parish, for the seven Years ending on the first of November One thousand eight hundred & thirty, is Twelve shillings & eleven pence half penny per Barrell, and I also Certify, that the average price of wheat, being the Corn also principally grown in said Parish for the period of seven Years ending on the first of November One thousand eight hundred and thirty is one pound, twelve shillings & six pence per Barrell Given under my hand this tenth first day of Octob: One thousand eight hundred & thirty three -
