

I John Stephend a Commissioner duly appointed to whom under and by virtue of  
an act passed in the 2 & 3 year of the Reign of his present Majesty King William  
the 4<sup>th</sup> intituled an act to amend three acts passed respectively in the 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and  
in the 7 & 8<sup>th</sup> years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing  
for the establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions  
permanent to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tithes arising  
bearing yielding or payable within the parish of Abbeystrowry in the Diocese of  
Cloyne and County of Cork I hereby certify that the second just amount of Composition for  
all tithes whatever within the said parish is six hundred and fifty five pounds by the year  
of which the sum of three hundred and six pounds eight shillings and nine pence is due and  
payable to Thomas Baldwin of Shabbreen + Mrs Alicia Baldwin of same place as aforesaid  
of said parish to wit the lands of Clewshill Tuaran Ratraibde Crolnagareeklnachasly  
Liosclraig Malenanahna Danglagya Millenawaller Inchinagalagh Hollybarr  
Ria Carrigalla Baunagallfe Currow with their subdenominations as lessors of the tithes  
of said portion of said parish under a lease thereof bearing date the nineteenth day of December  
one thousand eight hundred and seventeen for the term of one hundred and sixty years  
commencing from the day of the date thereof executed by John Sealy Townsend of the City  
of Dublin sonne Townsend otherwise Hardcastle his wife and Richard Townsend and Anne his  
wife by impresture of said tithes unto the said Thomas Baldwin and Mrs Alicia Baldwin  
and the sum of one hundred and two pounds four shillings & six pence out of part of  
the said sum of six hundred and fifty five pounds is due & payable of & unless on part thereof to wit  
the sum of forty seven pounds four shillings & two pence is due and payable to Thomas  
Baldwin & Mrs Alicia Baldwin as such lessor as aforesaid & the other part thereof  
leaving the sum of fifty six pounds is due and payable to the Reverend Messay B. McCarthy  
Rector & Vicar of the parish of Creagh the said last mentioned sum of one hundred and  
two pounds four shillings & six pence being due and payable out of part of the  
above portion of said parish to wit the lands of Rofbrugha Carrigfodda Richard  
Crolnagareeklnachasly with their subdenominations and the sum of two hundred & forty  
four pounds eleven shillings & one pence the residue of the aforesaid sum of six hundred and  
fifty five pounds is due and payable to Stephen Sweetnam of Moraghe out of the other  
portion of the said parish to wit the lands of Corone abbeyshawry Ria Lachertyduly &  
the Marsh Glonk U Lishenapugine Eastnamullie Dromis Lissaloung Barnagurane  
Craemore Cloughbarley and Deels with their subdenominations as lessors of the tithes of  
said last mentioned portion of said parish under a lease thereof bearing date the nineteenth  
day of December one thousand eight hundred and seventeen for the term of one hundred  
and sixty years commencing from the day of the date thereof executed by John Sealy Townsend  
and Anne Townsend otherwise Hardcastle his wife and Richard Townsend eldest son of the said  
John Sealy Townsend and Anne his wife by impresture.

I further certify that the average price of oats being the corn principally  
grown within the said County for the period of seven years ending the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November  
one thousand eight hundred and thirty is twelve shillings & eleven pence halfpenny  
per barrel
