Do hereby certify that at a Vestry held
on the 6th day of March 1835 for the composition of Tithes
in the Church of Colpe Dec Meath the Composition
was agreed to for one hundred & sixty five Pounds
for the Tithes of the Paroch of Colpe annually
& that one half of this sum is payable to the
Rev. & John Magee & the other half to W^m Dalton
Pollard Esq. - I do further certify that the
Average Price of Wheat being the same principally
grown in such Paroch for the period of seven years
ending on the 1st of Nov. 1830 is £1.12.10⁰/₁₀₀ per Bush
