We Thomas Lancaster of Fort William in the County of Roscommon and Walter Lambert Esq of Saint Elens in the County of Galway Esq^s Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act of Parliament made in the Fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth, which an Act to provide for the Establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, and another Act made to amend said Act in the Fifth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, for providing for the Establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland in order to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing and yielded, and payable within the Parish of " " in the Union of Athlone and Town of Tuam and County of Galway. Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of all Tithes whatsoever within the part of said Parish of Derrymacsherry belonging to the Union of Athlone, pursuant to agreement between the Tithe Owner and the Parishioners, and persons paying Tithes within such portion of said Parish is One hundred and ninety four pounds ten Shillings and ten pence. They payable half yearly from the first day of November One thousand eight hundred and twenty six by even parts on every first day of May and first day of November in every year which sum of One hundred and ninety four pounds ten Shillings and ten pence Sterling is due and payable to the Honble the Very Rev^d Archbishop C. L. P. Primate the Rector and his successors in equal proportions as aforesaid as a Composition claimable by him for all Tithes as Rector of said Parish, in said Union, and We do further Certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in that part of said County for the period of seven years ending the first day of November One thousand eight hundred and twenty one is One pound eighteen Shillings and eight pence half penny per Barrell
