and perform, the Powers and Authorities bestowed and  
reposed in me, as a Commissioner in the parish  
of Ballymorney part of the Union of Chapelizod  
in the County and County of Dublin, by virtue of an  
act passed in the fourth year of the reign of  
King George the fourth, entitled an act to provide  
for the establishment of Compositions for tithes in  
Ireland for a limited time, and of an act passed  
in the fifth year of his Majesty's reign, entitled  
an act to amend an act of the last Session of  
Parliament for providing for the establishment of  
Compositions of tithes in Ireland, and of an act passed  
in the seventh and eighth years of his Majesty's reign  
entitled an act to amend the acts for the establish-  
ment of Compositions for tithes in Ireland, according  
to the provisions of the said acts, and according to  
equity and good conscience, and without favour or  
opinion, prejudice or malice to any person or  
persons whatsoever
