the 18<sup>th</sup> of October 1824, for the true and just amount  
of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the  
said Parish is Three Hundred and Ninety  
Pounds, ~~the~~ which sum is due and payable  
to The Rev. William Peacocke as a Composition  
for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector ~~and~~  
of the said Parish. And we do hereby further  
certify that the average price of oats being  
the Corn principally grown in said County  
for the period of seven years ending on the
