

We the undersigned being the Rectors of the Parish of
Barna and being informed by virtue of an Act made in
the 11th year of the reign of King George the 3rd that the
Act to provide for the Establishment of a Corporation for the
Inhabitants of Barna to ascertain and fix a rate
and to make a Corporation for all by this Act being granted
or payable within the parish of Barna in the County of
Down Do hereby certify that the sum and the amount
of the Corporation for all by this Act whatever within the
parish is one Hundred and twenty five ^{pounds} British Sterling by
the year according to agreement. With this Certificate for the
Rector of the Parish of Barna at meeting duly assembled
pursuant to the Statute in that behalf made and provided and
which agreement has been duly ratified by the
majority of the Rectors of the said Parish of one Hundred and twenty
five pounds the whole is due and payable to him
as Rector of said Parish and we further certify that
it is also agreed upon that the above sum is to be
payable without Variation according to the price
of Corn in the Dublin Market for the space of
Twenty one years from the Date hereof Dated this
Day of September 1789 —
