

Agents before the said Justices at such Quarter sessions  
and the said Petition of Application Certificate and other  
documents having been produced and the said Justices  
having in pursuance of the Statutes in that case made  
and provided nominated James Richard Bull to be an  
arbitrator to ascertain the average price of the Bannock of  
good marketable wheat as advertised in the Dublin  
Gazette for the seven years immediately preceding the  
date of this present session. And the said James Richard  
Bull having by his report in writing under his hand  
certified to the said Justices that he had examined the  
said Gazette and taken the average price of wheat as  
therein advertised for said period of seven years and  
that the average price of wheat for said seven years  
is one pound seven shillings and six pence per  
Barrel

And the said Justices do find that the average  
price of wheat for the said seven years is as same was  
so reported by the said James Richard Bull as aforesaid  
and do order and adjudge that the amount of  
said Composition for Tithes in said Parish and the Tent  
charges payable in law thereof shall be diminished in  
proportion to the difference between the said average  
price of one pound seven shillings and six pence six  
pence and the said average price of one pound fifteen  
shillings and nine pence sterling and that the appor-  
-tment of said Composition shall be amended accordin-  
-gly and the said Justices do further order that the said  
reduction shall take effect from the first day of May  
one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven
